Phillip McLennan:	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Spoke on the major events precinct: the first meeting they attended had that the Wendouree no.2 area will come up in the part B refurbishment. Wendouree Little Aths did not feature on the draft plans at this stage.2. Second meeting with Lucas Carey (council), Football and Cricket clubs gave us an opportunity to have a say on what we would like which would mean prioritising the no.2 oval upgrade asap.3. We were asked to respond with a letter to allow us to let council know what the Wendouree athletic club needed eg. Discus nets, shot put rings. Re: Ballarat Major Events Precinct – Part B Response to Draft Report (24/6/2013) With consideration to the report as circulated the Wendouree Athletic Club forwards the following observations / comments:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No provision for athletic facilities (i.e. jump pits, throwing rings) included in plans.• Identified key points do not adequately reflect the priorities of the Wendouree Athletic Club.• Development of suitable facilities for hosting club activities main priority (circular running track, sprint lanes, jump pits and runways, throwing circles and sectors).• Appropriate storage amenity for jump mats, implements, etc• No stated preference for synthetic surface to replace existing grassed oval.• Acknowledge under a shared use arrangement with LWFNC and WCC a co-ordinated and co-operative approach is imperative.• Given the sub-standard, potentially dangerous condition of the number two oval, rendering it unusable for some tenant groups and therefore significantly underutilised, appropriate consideration be given to an efficient and timely restoration of its surface to allow fuller utilization.• Investigate integrated approach to development of facilities such as cricket practice nets, netball courts and athletics throwing cages; storage.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recognition that existing change facilities servicing No. 1 oval are poor. • Willingness to be party to future discussion re: development of indoor (social / meeting) facilities • Recognition that redevelopment of No 1 oval is a relative high cost project that needs to be done properly. • Inclusion of “<i>Major</i>” with regards to Part B of the precinct is a misnomer in terms of the proposed budget for the whole area. • Bulk of report bears little direct relation to the analysis / consideration of the requirements of the users. • Consultative process perceived as merely a perfunctory exercise in accordance with brief.
