Wendouree Athletic Club - 2019 Cross Country Report

The 2019 Cross Country Season came and went over the course of 33 events encompassing A.V. XCR, B.R.A.C. and club races. In total 437 participations were logged during the season with the Kingsley Curtis Handicap being the most attended event.

Open club championships were awarded to Andrew Amor (5km) and James Ham (8km, 10km) with Karla Treweek taking a clean sweep of the women's titles. Karla's stellar season carried over into B.R.A.C. races prevailing in the Wal Brown 8km CC, the Roseanne Brisbane Lap of the Lake and the Chas Suffren 6.4km. Harry Sharp also cleared the water and barriers at Smythesdale to win the men's Chas Suffren event. Justin Bleicher, James Ham, Archie Caldow, Andrew Amor and Angela Williams also claimed regional age group titles across the season.

At a state level Harry Sharp registered a win over 4km at St Anne's Winery and along with Claire Mahony, Archie Caldow, Matthew Catterson and Angela Williams also enjoyed notable results to score individual medals at XCR events. Representing the Ballarat Region Wendouree athletes contributed to team success, particularly in junior divisions, during 2019.

The association with Eureka Athletic Club for the majority of our local events has continued to be a positive arrangement. Thanks to all who contributed to the conduct of the season as officials, course planning and marking, collation and posting of results as well as the provision and preparation of post-race refreshments.

A review of the season identified dwindling numbers and course safety as major issues going forward. The disruption to the 2020 season by the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic has delayed the probable changes to a number of the club's course layouts, including traditional events such as the Kingsley Curtis Handicap, the King and Queen of the Mountain and the 5km Championship course at Victoria Park. Perversely perhaps the imposed restrictions of the prevailing health management crisis would seem to have actually triggered an increase in participation rates through the agency of the virtual program of events that has been implemented to maintain engagement with members. A point for consideration in planning for the future.

Heraclitus of Ephesus is attributed with the quote "change is the only constant in life". By accepting the inevitability of change and with appropriate planning, drawing on experience and encouraging innovation we can respect tradition and forge a positive path forward for the activities of the club in these dynamic times.

2020 CROSS COUNTRY REPORT

The Woady Athletic Club 2020 Cross Country Season commenced on April 9th weekend with concerns of social distancing being brought by the COVID-19 Pandemic.

As a result it was decided that we would commence the season with weeks of VIRTUAL runs where families were given set days to complete a set course mostly in Haddon along the rail trail, Haddon Lions Park and the Haddon Common.

It was also decided that there would be no registration costs, but families were required to email/txt to Peter their intentions of registration. All families 'registered' have been included in the seasons database.

Approximately 56 runners have indicated that they would take part and run the set distances. This is fantastic as the club has never had this amount of cross country registrations before.

All results are recorded on spreadsheet as well as being entered in the clubs website – Cross Country results, which continuously works out each race handicap results. The program also gives aggregate points for each run which will give a progressive total at the end of season To note that with families doing their own runs, mums and dads are competing as well. They too collate progressive handicap points.

All runners have been encouraged to run in club singlets and have pics taken which have been posted on Team App and Facebook along with results

The interest in the virtual runs will give us some thought as we go ahead beyond the COVID-19 restrictions. A positive thought and one the committee should give a positive direction for the remainder of the season and for future seasons
