Peter Luke Life Membership...

Joined: 13/11/1971.

President: 1994 - 1997.

Vice President: 1993/94; 1998/99.

Peter Luke joined the Wendouree Amateur Athletic Club as a 13 year-old for the 1971/72 track and field season. An all-round competitor Peter contested middle and sprint distances along with the horizontal jumps, throws as well as developing an infinity for race walking. Peter also competed in cross-country claiming the 1972 King of the Mountain title.

Whilst life and work took Pete down various paths over the years, he has maintained an enduring link with Wendouree. Active on the committee he served as President for three years as well as stints as vice president. Peter continued to be active on the track well into his veteran years, whilst more recently he has increasingly contributed to the conduct of the competition as an official acting as a starter and walk judge. A legacy of Peter's contribution to the sport has been the success of the Woady Yaloak Athletics Club. Established by Peter, under the auspices of Wendouree, 25 years ago the Woady Yaloak club has provided numerous junior athletes an introduction into the sport of athletics.

The Luke family has had a long association with the Wendouree Athletic Club. Peter's father, Bob, was a respected club competitor in the late 1950s returning to the track with the advent of the veteran's competition as well as contributing as a manager of the club's junior teams. His mother Faye has been a long-time supporter of the club and was instrumental in the Ladies Committee for many years.

Over the course of the past 50 years Peter Luke has made a meaningful contribution to the Wendouree Athletic Club and is a worthwhile recipient of life membership.
