1.1. Previous Minutes

2. AVSL Items

2.1. 2024/25 Season Schedule Updates - For Approval

Following the opening round and entries for round two, several patterns started to emerge for the AVSL schedule. It was clear after Round One that more people wanted to complete 3 attempts at Javelin and Shot Put and we needed to convert the sheets. After filling up the Discus sheets in Round Two another pattern emerged.

Athletics Ballarat recommend the following changes to the AVSL Schedule in Ballarat

Removal of Throw & Go sheets for Javelin & Discus to convert to regular sheets (Sheets filled up
quickly and interest is there for another sheet with three attempts). Members can still choose to one
attempt but all entries on sheet will get three attempts - Strongly Recommended

APPROVED

• Removal of Sheet 5 Throw & Go for Shot Put and convert to regular sheet (Still have one Throw & Go for Shot Put but have 5 regular sheets including Seated Throws) Strongly Recommended

ALTERNATE RECOMMENDATION APPROVED

Rd 5 - Shot Put throw and go to remain sheet 5, and convert sheet 3 to regular sheet.

- Moving Triple & Long Jump Controlled Sheets to Sheet 1 and swapping with regular sheet (Controlled jumps were clashing with sprints, this will help avoid this while maintaining numbers).
 The number of total sheets will stay the same - Strongly Recommended APPROVED
- Adding an extra Discus Sheet to start at 5:30pm in Round 4 & 6. The sheet would add an extra 20 spots for discus throwers but extend the program. Recommended

APPROVED as a Throw and Go Sheet.

In addition to the recommendations put forward the following additional items were approved:

- To start the first sheet of high jump 30 minutes earlier.
- To request that Athletics Victoria add starting times to track events on the Rev Sport entry system.
- To request that Ballarat Entries open at Midday Sunday instead of 5pm Wednesday.

2.2. Controlled Sheet Details

In the first week of competitions we had 14 members compete in the Controlled Javelin, 9 members in the Controlled Shot Put and 1 in the controlled Triple Jump

Looking over the statistics on results in those sheets, it's clear that some members shouldn't have entered these sheets. For the most obvious ones, they have been sent an email and asked not to enter controlled sheets again. It is clear however that the criteria was set too high as there were a few members that fell just short

If a member clearly does not meet the requirements for a controlled sheet, Athletics Ballarat would have the right to remove them from the sheet. - Strongly Recommended 1 APPROVED - To be at the discretion of the Admin team.

Athletics Ballarat would like to reduce the Controlled sheet criteria to the below - Strongly Recommended APPROVED as per table below. Whilst Long Jump and Discus were not specifically listed, it was agreed that the they should remain as they currently are.

2.3. Officials Points Allocation

Discussion held based upon information in the Agenda.

Agreement from all that the intent of rewarding officials is correct yet there is still considerable detail missing. Agreement was found on the following:

- NEW Officials should be rewarded from Week 1.
- Those putting in more than 100% of the schedule, eg admin and tech, should be eligible for a full 600 points. Points for all others should start at 500.
- Ballarat Officials who AV are not recognising yet possess the appropriate qualifications and experience should be reinstated as officials.

ACTIONS:

- Clubs provide a list of Officials they would like recognised with a short bio and explanation as to why they should be reinstated as officials.
- Athletics Ballarat to consolidate the list from all clubs and formally request that AV reinstate the officials listed. Letter from Craig W

- Once Officials have been allocated, Matt to send to all clubs on Officials. Completed

It was agreed that from Round 4 onwards, a waitlist for all field events should be added. It will be at the discretion of the Administration team on who will be promoted from the waitlist, with preference given to Ballarat, then Geelong athletes.

3.1 Unpaid Track Fees

An update was provided to the committee on unpaid track fees and feedback sought on how to manage these moving forward:

The committee supported the following actions:

- 1. Clubs to be emailed the list of unpaid athletes.
- 2. CLubs to follow up as well as Athletics Ballarat.
- 3. Any Athletes remaining unpaid at the completion of Round 4, will not be eligible to score points from Round 5 onwards until all track fees are paid.
